

# STELLA TOWN BOARD MINUTES

## AUGUST 13, 2013

### 5 PM

**Present:** Chair David Brunette, Supervisor Bob Goodin, Supervisor Deb Polinski, Clerk J. Fish, Treasurer K. Baker  
 Approximately 20 tax payers were present at the meeting.

Chair Brunette called the meeting to order at 5 PM. Quorum Present. Meeting notice posted on 3 town bulletin boards and also on the town website [www.tn.stella.wi.gov/](http://www.tn.stella.wi.gov/)

Minutes were distributed and reviewed. A Motion to accept the minutes as distributed was made by Bob Goodin, seconded by D. Polinski, Motion carried.

<p>Treasurer's Report-July 2013</p>	<p>The Treasurer gave a report of the town's revenue and expense accounts for the month ending July 31, 2013. A motion was made by Deb Polinski, seconded by Bob Goodin, to approve the Treasurer's report, Motion carried.</p>
<p>Old Business:</p>	<p>Superv. Goodin stated that both Tenderfoot Rd. and Warehouse Rd. have been completed and chip sealed. Bob spoke to Oettinger and he has now completed grading the roads as requested. He did part of Rosevelt Rd., Spring Dr., Cross Country Rd. (including putting in a new culvert) and Warehouse Rd. Bob also ordered two new fire numbers for new residences and a new road sign for Berger Road. Lilac Lane culvert was plugged and Bob asked Bruce Eades to trap the beaver. He has trapped 1 beaver to date. Bob also requested Danny Matson to do some brushing per request on Cambria Point.</p>
<p>New Business</p>	<p>Supervisor Deb Polinski said she had been asked about whether the original town dump property was for sale. Deb said this will have to be looked into. It is across the road from the currently closed dump on Rasmusson Rd.</p> <p>Bob Feldman is almost done with the brushing alongside of designated roads, with Deerhorn Rd. left to do. Dan Matson will do Berger Rd. Bob said there is approximately .8 mile on E. Stella Lake Road that needs work. He will contact Oneida County to do this. When they are on their way back to the Cty. Shop they can also take in 3<sup>rd</sup> Lake Rd. This should be next week. Rich Hirman asked how a person can get on the priority list to have a road graded, graveled, or chip sealed, whichever the road needs. Supervisor Goodin said to call him. He does a lot of driving around the town to check the roads, but a request from the taxpayer is crucial to getting on a prioritized list. The clerk took the names of those taxpayers that indicated their roads needed attention to bring them into good driving condition. Bob will follow up on each of these requests and bring the information back to the next Town Bd. meeting.</p> <p>Jean Ebbe requested to speak at this meeting regarding a "no wake" zone that had been discussed and disapproved at the May Town Bd. meeting. She said the DNR rep from the Antigo office said they would approve it if the Town would approve it. The Board emphasized that there is already a no wake zone 100 ft. from the shoreline and they felt this to be adequate. No new action was taken.</p>
