✓ <b>Call meeting to order</b>	Chair, D. Brunette	Quorum present. Meeting notice posted on the three town bulletin boards as required.
✓ <b>Review and approve August 2009 Minutes</b>	Chair, D. Brunette	A motion was made by D. Polinski, seconded by D. Brunette, to approve the minutes as distributed. Motion carried.
✓ <b>Review and approve Aug. 2009 Treasurer's Report</b>	Chair, D. Brunette	The Treasurer gave a summary of the town accounts, including balances and expected revenues. A motion was made by D. Brunette, seconded by D. Polinski to approve the Treasurer's Report as read. Motion carried.
✓ <b>Old Business</b>	Chair, D. Brunette	Discussion centered various roads that need work.
<b>Road Work</b>	Chair, D. Brunette	Dave said Pitlik and Wick will be finishing approximately .24 miles of blacktop on Camp Bryn Afton Road project before cold weather. This will be approximately \$14,992. The job was split into two sections in case we run out of funds to complete the entire project this year. A proposal was received on the apron in front of the new fire station for \$4,910. This also may be put on hold until next year. A motion was made by R. Goodin, seconded by Deb Polinski to proceed with the first portion of this road project on Camp Bryn Afton Road. All aye, motion carried. Discussion also was held on road work needed on Stella Lake Road and Piehls Point Road. Bob G. will follow up on these areas and identify exactly what needs to be done and how soon we need to get to it. Some road work will need to be delayed until next year due to budget.

✓ **New Business**

**Potential periodic setup of irrigation system that would include crossing Snowden Road with underground power line and, approval for passage of center Pivot on Snowden Road. This request was made by Brian Bowen of the Rhinelander Agriculture Research Station.**

This was discussed to some length and it was decided that B. Bowen should talk to adjoining property owners and get their input. Also Bowen should talk to the state regarding liability factors. The town will ask their attorney for an opinion on the liability issue also. The Supervisors will contact other townships that may have a similar issue to see what they have done. Brian will return to the Town Board with more information at a future date.
